- Proficient in Basic Scout Skills including Knots, First Aid, Orienteering, Camping.
- Completed one 6-month term as Senior Patrol Leader or Assistant Senior Patrol Leader
- Completed or Enrolled in National Youth Leadership Training

Troop Guide

- Must be 14 years of age or older.
- Earned Life Scout Rank.
- Proficient in Basic Scout Skills including Knots, First Aid, Orienteering, Camping.
- Completed one 6-month term as Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader or Senior Patrol Leader.

Instructor

- Must be 13 years of age or older.
- Earned First Class Scout Rank.
- Proficient in Basic Scout Skills including Knots, First Aid, Orienteering, Camping.
- Earned two of the following Merit Badges:
 - Pioneering
 - Camping
 - Cooking
 - First Aid
 - Emergency Preparedness
 - Hiking or Backpacking
