

Summer Camp Packing List

Label EVERYTHING with scout's first name and last initial and T313.

- Footlocker
- Combination locks for footlocker
- Towels (microfiber)
 - We bought 2 sets-one color for pool and one color for shower
- Toiletries (In a Ziploc)
 - 3 in 1 shower wash
 - Deodorant
 - Toothbrush and Toothpaste
 - Comb, etc
- Mattress or Mat to go on cot
 - Doesn't require electric pumps
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag
- Twin bed sheet (in case the bag is too warm)
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Mosquito net for over cot
- Cord for laundry line/bungee laundry line
- Shower/pool/lake shoes
- Closed toe shoes sneakers/boots
- Money for trading post
- Money for on the road meals
- Hat (scout or otherwise)
- Small Battery Operated Fan (for cot/sleeping)
- Flashlight
 - Possibly hands free with higher illumination
- Battery operated lamp for tent
- Extra batteries for all
- Mesh laundry bag for dirty clothes
- Clothing for each day plus extra (check weather for Camp Henson)
 - I send older clothes
 - I rolled shorts, tshirt, undies and socks and put in a Ziploc
 - Extra underwear and socks
- Hoodie and Sweatpants
- Bathing Suit (and Shirt)
- Swim goggles
- Field (Class A) uniform
- Rain gear (poncho)
- Small first aid kit
- Gold Bond Powder
- Cards and fun, smaller board games – no electronics
- Scout book and other scout essentials
- Day Pack
- Refillable water bottle (insulated, with strap or can go in day pack)

- Pocket knife (optional with Totin' Chip)
- Camp Chair
- Wear Activity (Class B) uniform
- Prescription medication
 - should be in the original container with enough to last through the week of camp
 - give to medical officer before departure or self-carry
- Merit Badge Schedule
- Camp Map in sheet protector
- Weekly schedule
- Printed Merit Badge packet
- Prerequisite work and supplies (Ex: golf clubs, fishing pole, etc)
- Medical form parts A, B and C (Part C signed by a medical professional), COVID forms, etc (by designated due date)
- Water proof case (for phone)
- **In a day pack (for Sunday), bring:**
 - A REFILLABLE WATER BOTTLE (one with a strap or insulated may be helpful)
 - In a folder:
 - Bring a copy of your merit badge schedule, previously provided (one extra copy will be at camp in case one gets lost)
 - Print and bring a copy of the camp map (can be found on camp website)
 - Print and bring a copy of the weekly schedule (can be found on website)
 - Print packets and bring any pre-requisite work for the merit badges that you have completed and something to write with
 - A bathing suit and a towel for the swim test on Sunday
 - Be prepared to take even if you already passed the test
 - Activity (Class B) uniform
 - Money for food on Sunday (which we may get on the way to camp)
- Wear Field uniform (Class A)

There may be a change in uniform for the day of departure. One will be worn and one will be packed in day pack. An announcement will be made prior to departure.

***Knives may not be purchased at camp without a parent letter to the Scoutmaster delivered prior to camp.

***If you are mailing a note, etc. to camp, send early in the week.
